IN

These common words are prepositions that show a relationship between two words in a sentence.

The preposition In is used for general, bigger times and places.

For times:

Centuries: in the 1700's

Decade's: in the 80's

Years: in 2023

Months: in the June

Week: in last two weeks

Seasons: in winter

Part of the day: in the morning, in the afternoon

Periods of time: in the future.. in the past

For location:

Country: in America

City: in Kabul

Neighborhood: in Dawlatzai

Rooms: in living room, ...

Enclosed space Or Small transportation: in a car, in a boat, in a taxi

ON

Preposition On is used for more specific times and small places.

For times

Specific date: on 5th june

Days of the week: on Friday

Specific holidays which end with DAY: on Birthday,

Time: on the weekend

Day+ part of the day: on the Monday morning

For places

Streets: on prince street

Avenues: on the ocean avenue

Islands:

Large vehicles : on the bus, on the aeroplane, on the train, on the ship,

Surfaces: on the floor

Communication devices: on the radio, on the telephone

AT

Preposition At is used for very specific times and very specific places

For time

Hours: at one o'clock

For the most Specific time: at night, at midday, at noon, at midnight

Holidays without Day: at the easter time

For place

Address: at 76-89 church street

Very specific location: at Roma store, At home, at school, at college, at university, at class

For/ To

Use “to” when the reason or purpose is a verb.

Use “for” when the reason or purpose is a noun.

Ex: I bought a present to give to Sarah on her birthday.

Ex: She came here for resting.

Or

For is used

Benefits: Yugort is good for digestion.

Period of time: I have been there for two days.

Schedule: I will go to English course for next summer.

Agree with : You came here for teaching?

To is used

Destination: I am going to the city.

Time description: It is quarter to ten.

Distance: How long is Kabul to Jalalabad?

Made of/ Made from/ Made with

Made of

Is used for those things in which original material is still recognisable.

Ex: My chair is made of wood.

Ex: My Desk is made of wood.

Made from

Is used for those things in which original material is not recognisable.

Ex: Wine is made from grapes.

Ex: Paper is made from trees.

Made with

Used for those things which is made with many ingrediential materials.

Ex: A cake is made with sugar, glucose ...

Home/House



House: is the building in which other people live. Or is the place that is made for people to live.

Ex: They live in small house.



Home: is the place where you live and feel belong to you. Or Home is the place where you feel comfort and safe.

Ex: I go to home.

Ex: I have a big home.

Ex: Nangarhar is my home city.

Wedding/ Marriage

Wedding: is the party or ceremony of having wedlock with a male/female.
